

He is the author of *Whither the World: The Political Economy of the Future* (Palgrave, 2014) and of *Truth, Errors and Lies: Economics and Politics in a Volatile World* (Columbia University Press, 2011). He has written widely for international media and his books have been translated into 16 different languages.
